

Donor Privacy Policy – Brief Version

All information concerning donors or prospective donors, including their names, addresses and telephone numbers, the names of their beneficiaries, the amount of their gift, etc., shall be kept strictly confidential by the Buddy Program, its staff and volunteers, unless permission is obtained from donors to release such information.

Donor Privacy Policy

The Buddy Program is committed to respecting the privacy of donors. The types of donor information that it collects and maintains are as follows: Contact information: name, address, telephone number and email address, giving information, information on events attended, publications received, special requests for program information, information provided by the donor in the form of comments and suggestions.

The Buddy Program uses donors' information to understand their interests in its mission and to update them on the organization's plans and activities. This information is shared with staff, board members, volunteers and consultants only on a "need-to-know" basis. The Buddy Program lists donors' names on its website to acknowledge their contribution; donors may 'opt out' of this list by contacting the staff member listed below.

Emails will only be passed on to a third party under specific circumstances approved by the Buddy Program, for the purposes of reaching out to donors on behalf of the Buddy Program. The primary example of this is when we use a third-party mailing house or partner organization's mailing house for certain events and appeals. Information in this case is shared only for one specific use, per agreement with our vendors and partners, and will not be used by the vendor or partner for any other purpose.
